Answer Key — Rhyming Words

For the teacher / parent. Do not distribute with the worksheet.

1. cat, hat (*Cat and hat rhyme because they both end with -at*)
2. sun, run (*Sun and run rhyme because they both end with -un*)
3. pig, big (*Pig and big rhyme because they both end with -ig*)
4. hop, mop (*Hop and mop rhyme because they both end with -op*)
5. tree, bee (*Tree and bee rhyme because they both end with -ee*)
6. fan, pan (*Fan and pan rhyme because they both end with -an*)
7. bug, rug (*Bug and rug rhyme because they both end with -ug*)
8. fox, box (*Fox and box rhyme because they both end with -ox*)
9. nest, rest (*Nest and rest rhyme because they both end with -est*)
10. cake, lake (*Cake and lake rhyme because they both end with -ake*)
11. train, rain (*Train and rain rhyme because they both end with -ain*)
12. night, light (*Night and light rhyme because they both end with -ight*)
