

Sorting by Size, Color, and Shape

Grade K • MATH • Sorting objects by size, color, or shape and counting how many are in each group •
Standards: K.MD.B.3

Look at each group of objects. Sort them and count how many are in each group. Write your answer.

1. There are 2 red apples and 1 green apple. How many red apples are there?
2. There are 3 big dogs and 2 small dogs. How many big dogs are there?
3. There are 4 circles and 1 square. How many circles are there?
4. There are 2 blue flowers, 3 yellow flowers, and 1 red flower. How many yellow flowers are there?
5. There are 5 small buttons and 2 big buttons. How many small buttons are there?
6. There are 3 triangles, 2 circles, and 4 squares. How many squares are there?
7. There are 6 purple grapes and 3 green grapes. How many grapes are purple?
8. There are 4 long pencils and 5 short pencils. How many short pencils are there?
9. There are 2 orange carrots, 3 red tomatoes, and 4 green beans. How many green beans are there?
10. There are 5 big rectangles, 3 small rectangles, and 2 triangles. How many small rectangles are there?
