Read the name of each animal. Write the habitat where it lives: ocean, forest, desert, or farm.

1. A shark swims in the water all day. Where does a shark live?
2. A chicken lays eggs and eats corn. Where does a chicken live?
3. A camel walks on hot sand and has a hump on its back. Where does a camel live?
4. A deer hides among the trees and eats leaves. Where does a deer live?
5. A cow gives us milk and lives with other farm animals. Where does a cow live?
6. A dolphin jumps in the waves and swims with fish. Where does a dolphin live?
7. An owl sleeps in a tree during the day and hunts at night. Where does an owl live?
8. A scorpion hides under rocks where it is very dry and hot. Where does a scorpion live?
9. A seahorse has a curly tail and floats in salty water. Where does a seahorse live?
10. A pig rolls in the mud and eats from a trough. Where does a pig live?
