1. solid (*A rock keeps its shape.*)
2. liquid (*Water flows and takes the shape of the cup.*)
3. solid (*A pencil keeps its shape.*)
4. liquid (*Juice flows and takes the shape of its container.*)
5. solid (*A block keeps its shape.*)
6. liquid (*Milk flows and takes the shape of the bottle.*)
7. solid (*A spoon keeps its shape.*)
8. liquid (*Oil flows and takes the shape of its container.*)
9. solid (*A toy car keeps its shape.*)
10. liquid (*Rainwater flows and takes the shape of the puddle.*)
