

Day and Night Sky

Grade K • SCIENCE • Students identify the sun, moon, and stars and sort simple sky scenes as day or night. • Standards: 1-ESS1-1

Look at each picture or sentence. Write or say your answer about what you see in the sky!

1. Picture: A big bright yellow circle in the sky. What is this?
2. Picture: A white circle in the dark sky. What is this?
3. Picture: Many tiny white dots in the dark sky. What are these?
4. The sky is bright and blue. The sun is shining. Is this day or night?
5. The sky is dark. You can see stars. Is this day or night?
6. Picture: A bright sky with the sun and some clouds. Is this a day sky or a night sky?
7. Picture: A dark sky with the moon and many stars. Is this a day sky or a night sky?
8. When you see the sun high in the sky, it is usually daytime. True or false?
9. Picture: A dark sky with stars and a white moon. Which three things do you see?
10. Picture A shows a bright blue sky with the sun. Picture B shows a dark sky with stars. Which picture shows nighttime?
