Look at each object. Write which sense you use most to learn about it: sight, hearing, smell, taste, or touch.

1. A red apple
2. A loud bell
3. A fresh flower
4. A sweet cookie
5. A soft blanket
6. A yellow sun in the sky
7. A drum making noise
8. Fresh bread baking
9. Salty popcorn to eat
10. A bumpy rock

Answer Key — Explore the Five Senses

For the teacher / parent. Do not distribute with the worksheet.

1. sight (*We see the color and shape of the apple with our eyes.*)
2. hearing (*We hear the sound of the bell with our ears.*)
3. smell (*We smell the flower's scent with our nose.*)
4. taste (*We taste the cookie's flavor with our tongue.*)
5. touch (*We feel how soft the blanket is with our hands and skin.*)
6. sight (*We see the sun and its color with our eyes.*)
7. hearing (*We hear the drum's sound with our ears.*)
8. smell (*We smell the bread with our nose.*)
9. taste (*We taste the salty flavor with our tongue.*)
10. touch (*We feel the bumps on the rock with our hands.*)
