

The Four Seasons

Grade K • SCIENCE • Students identify the four seasons by recognizing simple patterns in trees, clothing, weather, and activities. • Standards: K-ESS2-1

Look at each clue and write which season it is: spring, summer, fall, or winter.

1. The tree has green leaves and it is very hot outside. Which season is it?
2. A girl wears a heavy coat, hat, and mittens to go outside. Which season is it?
3. The tree has new buds and baby birds are in the nest. Which season is it?
4. The leaves on the tree are orange and red and falling to the ground. Which season is it?
5. A boy wears shorts and sandals to play at the park. Which season is it?
6. The tree has no leaves at all and the branches are bare. Which season is it?
7. Flowers are blooming and the grass is turning green again. Which season is it?
8. A family picks apples from a tree with yellow and brown leaves. Which season is it?
9. The days are getting warmer, ice is melting, and tiny green leaves are starting to grow on trees. Which season is it?
10. The tree has full green leaves, children swim at the pool, and the days are long and warm. Which season is it?
