7. A sailboat uses wind to move across the lake. Does a sailboat travel on land, water, or air?
8. A truck carries boxes on the highway. Does a truck travel on land, water, or air?
9. A helicopter flies above the trees. Does a helicopter travel on land, water, or air?
10. A ferry carries people and cars across the river. Does a ferry travel on land, water, or air?
